Aboriginal and Treaty Rights and Interests (ATRI) Forum

The ATRI Forum, hosted by the Province of Ontario, will focus on discussing potential impacts to potentially affected Indigenous communities' Aboriginal and/or Treaty Rights and Interests for the following Projects:

- Webequie Supply Road (WSR)
- Northern Road Link (NRL)
- Marten Falls First Nation Community Access Road (MFFN CAR)

The ATRI Forum will feature presentations, activities, and breakout sessions to provide a respectful, culturally-sensitive and collaborative space to develop an understanding of Aboriginal and/or Treaty Rights and Interests in any of the Project areas.

Representatives from NRL, MFFN CAR, WSR, the Agency and the Province will be in attendance.
